2d. Handling Extra Heats

Extra heat sheets are due to the home pool by noon the day of the meet. The home team should then combine all the heats and make copies of the finished heat sheets for the away team to use in the staging of the kids.

Example:

10 year old girls freestyle: 5 lane pool
