NBSL Championship Awards

These awards are presented during the NBSL Championship Meet..

1. Individual and Relay Awards:

- a. Awards are given to the top ten individual finishers in any given event.
 - i. Places 1-10 will receive awards.
 - ii. Heat winners will be awarded for 12 and Under.
- b. Relays: Places 1-10 will receive awards.
- c. Only coaches can pick up awards. Teams are responsible for contacting the pool assigned to organize awards to pick up any awards not picked up during the meet.

2. Team Trophies:

- a. The winner of each division for the dual meet season.
- b. The 1st-3rd place teams in the classic division and the 1st-3rd place teams in the invitational division.
- c. Sportsmanship has always been a guiding principle of the NBSL that extends to swimmers, coaches, volunteers and family and friends. Annually, team representatives from each division are allowed a single vote (excluding their team) and a **team trophy** is awarded to the division winners during the NBSL Championship Meet.
 - We hope you will take the time during the season to teach and exhibit good sportsmanship. We urge you to cast your vote for the team that best demonstrates competitive swimming through friendly competition. Please submit your votes to the NBSL President one week before the NBSL Championship Meet.

3. Specialty Awards:

- a. The Susie Soltis Trophy is awarded to the 6 and Under Girls Backstroke Winner.
- b. The Chris Starkey Trophy is awarded to the 12 and Under Boys Freestyle Winner
- c. The Stella Williams Trophy is awarded to the 12 and Under Girls Breaststroke Winner.
- d. The Bruce E Smith Trophy is awarded to the 18 and Under Girls Backstroke Winner.
- e. The Savannah Strong Trophy is awarded to the Classic division Girls 10 and Under Butterfly Winner.
- f. The 10 and Under Medley Relay Trophy is awarded to the Boys and Girls winning team for that age group.
