

# NBSL CLASSIC MEET

**Saturday, July 13, 2019**

<b>Directions</b>	<p><u>From Naamans Road:</u> Turn south on Marsh Road/Rt 3. Go past Grubb Road and Old Orchard Road and the pool is on your right.</p> <p><u>From Silverside Road:</u> Take Silverside Road east towards Branmar Plaza. Turn left onto Marsh Road. Go past Forward Mano and the pool is on your left.</p>
<b>Parking</b>	<p>It is best to park at Forwood Elementary School followed by a short walk to the back of the Graylyn Crest Facility. Forward Elementary is accessed from Silverside Road- turn onto Floral Road (in North Graylyn Crest development) then turn right onto Matwood Road and right onto Westminster Drive. Forwood is not accessible from Marsh Road. Please check the NBSL website for additional information and a map. <a href="http://www.nbslswim.com">www.nbslswim.com</a></p>
<b>Eligibility</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Swimmers who have <b>NOT</b> met the qualifying time for a given individual stroke for the Invitational Meet are invited to attend the Classic Meet.</li><li>● Swimmers must have competed in at least two dual meets during the NBSL season.</li></ul>
<b>Eligibility Limitations</b>	<p>Swimmers who have met the qualifying time for an individual even must swim in the Invitational Meet: they may <b>NOT</b> swim that event at the Classic Meet.</p>
<b>Rules</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● All NBSL league rules and the Code of Conduct will be in effect.</li><li>● Swimmer's age is as of June 1st current year, same as for dual meets,</li><li>● The Classic Meet will be run as a positive check-in meet. Swimmer's heat and lane assignments will be made on the day of the meet after swimmers have checked in.</li><li>● Dual confirmation of a stroke or turn disqualification will be in effect for all events as swimmer's at this age and ability sometimes have awkward, but proper, mechanics.</li><li>● If a coach has a question or an issue during the course of the meet, it should be directed only to the meet referee. The name of the referee will be announced prior to the start of the meet.</li></ul> <p><b><u>SPECIAL RULES FOR 6&amp;U SWIMMERS</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● The only 6&amp;U events at this meet are Freestyle and Backstroke. 6&amp;U swimmers who wish to swim Breaststroke or Butterfly may swim as an 8&amp;U but will be subject to 8&amp;U disqualification rules.</li></ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● A 6&amp;U should <b>only</b> be entered into an event if they can consistently swim the stroke. There <b>WILL</b> be disqualification of swimmers in 6&amp;U events at this meet.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Entry Procedures</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Swimmers are limited to 2 individual events at this meet. In addition to the 2 individual events, swimmers may participate in a relay event. Each club may enter only one relay team per relay event.</li> <li>● Swimmers may swim up in age, but may not swim the same stroke in different age groups.</li> <li>● Entries with “no time” N.T. are not allowed.</li> <li>● <i>Swimmers who <b>DO NOT</b> have a Qualifying time for the NBSL Invitational meet in the freestyle are allowed to participate in the mixed relay. A swimmer who enters the free relay in the Classic meet is still eligible to swim on a relay team on the NBSL Invitational.</i></li> <li>● Fee is \$2.75 per individual event and \$4.00 per relay.</li> <li>● Coaches must submit the names of swimmers attending this meet and their entry times to the NBSL on <b>Monday July 8th 2019 by 6 PM</b>. Entries must be emailed to <a href="mailto:entries@nbslswim.com">entries@nbslswim.com</a>. See the NBSL website for entry procedures. Payment for Classic events will be collected along with Invitational entries.</li> <li>● Coaches must submit the names of swimmers who qualify for the Invitational after entries are collected <b>by Friday July 12th at 4 PM</b> so they may be scratched from the meet. Teams will receive an entry fee credit for these swimmers towards the Invitational. Only swimmers achieving qualifying times may receive credit.</li> <li>● Do not submit entries for swimmers that you know will not show up for the meet.</li> <li>● This meet will be run as a <b>positive check-in meet</b>. All swimmers must arrive during the check-in time to be seated in appropriate heat. NBSL will process the no-shows and produce the heat sheets with heat and lane assignments the morning of the meet.</li> <li>● <b>NOTE:</b> If a swimmer is not checked in by 7:30am, NBSL officials will do their best to accommodate the swimmer, but due to the nature of this meet, the entry and/or the proper heat can not be guaranteed. Therefore, make certain all swimmers arrive for mandatory check-in before 7:30am!</li> </ul>
<p><b>Meet Volunteers</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● The NBSL requires that each swim team provide volunteers to help run this meet. All of the positions needed for a Dual meet are needed for this meet as well-times, runners, starters, announcer and Stroke and Turn officials.</li> <li>● Each team’s coach or NBSL representative will be responsible for submitting the names of volunteers by the <b>Sunday before the meet</b> on paper or via Sign Up Genius. Please check the website for the current link for this meet. (<a href="http://www.nbslswim.com">www.nbslswim.com</a>)</li> <li>● Volunteers do not work the whole meet! Each job is broken into shifts and volunteers works for 2-3 hours in their specific job.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Kids, 13 and up, can volunteer to be runners, Kids over 16 can volunteer to be timers. Volunteer hours can count as community service.</li> </ul>
<b>Admission Fees</b>	Volunteers/ Officials/Swimmers.....free Families/Guests.....\$5.00 per spectator, children under 12 are free Meet Program book.....free with admission cost )program will be a Psych sheet with additional programs listing lanes and heats handed out as they are finished with seeding)

<b>Warm Ups</b>	Warm up schedules will be determined based on meet entries and will be announced at least 48 hours before the meet. The schedule will be sent to coaches and posted on the NBSL website ( <a href="http://www.nbslswim.com">www.nbslswim.com</a> ) and at the meet.
<b>Officials/ Coaches Meetings</b>	6:45am Officials report and sign in 7:50am Timers meeting with Head Timer 7:50am Place Judges and Stroke & Turn meeting with Referee 8:00am Coaches Meeting for final corrections/scratches and any questions 8:30am Relay swimmer names on index cards are due to the Scoring Table.

<b>Awards</b> <i>Only coaches may pick up the awards</i>	Individual Events <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>First place through sixth place will receive medals.</li> <li>Seventh place to tenth place will receive ribbons.</li> </ul> Relay Events <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>First through third place will receive medals.</li> <li>Fourth through tenth will receive ribbons.</li> </ul> Heat winner ribbons will also be provided. Participation ribbons will be awarded to all 6&U swimmers if they do not finish in the top 10, even if they are disqualified.
<b>Scoring of the Meet</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Scoring will be based on the final results of the race. The top 16 individuals in each race will score points for their team as follows (20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1)</li> <li>For individual events, only the top 2 swimmers from each team score points.</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Place and time will be determined primarily by the Colorado Timing System.</li> <li>▪ The Classic meet will declare its own champion. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. The points will not carry over from the Classic to the Invitational meets.</li> <li>2. There will be a 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place trophy for this meet</li> <li>3. The relays at the Classic will not be scored</li> <li>4. The classic meet will be a 'last chance' meet to qualify for the Invitational. If a swimmer makes a time for a stroke, they will be allowed to swim in the Invitational meet. <i>Please include swimmers wishing to swim in the Invitational with your Invitational swimmer entries.</i></li> </ol> </li> </ul>
<b>Refreshments</b>	<p>Graylyn Crest Swim Club will host a Snack bar with a variety of food and drinks. Teams and individuals are also allowed to bring in food and drinks for their own consumption. Volunteers will get some tickets for free refreshments.</p>
<b>Tee Shirt sales</b>	<p>NBSL will be selling Tee shirts with the League's 2019 logo at the meet in a variety of sizes for swimmers and families.</p>
